

## Obituary for Kevin McGuire

Kevin Lucas McGuire, 44, of Fort Collins, died Aug. 10, 2007, at Medical Center of the Rockies following a traumatic motorcycle accident. Kevin was born March 6, 1963, in Los Angeles to Richard McGuire and Joyce Colvett Chase of Modesto, Calif.
