VENICE, Florida -- Richard A. Moses, formerly of Lunenburg, MA, passed away August 5th, at the age of 81.

Born in Fitchburg, MA on September 10, 1934, the son of J. Walter Moses and Florence (Filiau) Moses, he lived in Lunenburg since 1948. Richard graduated from Fitchburg Vocational School and East Coast Aero Tech in Bedford, MA, and was awarded a U.S. license to work on aircraft.

Mr. Moses served four years in the [United States Navy](#) from 1952-1956, during the [Korean conflict](#). He worked at Republic Aviation in Farmingdale, N.Y. during the [Vietnam War](#) as a flight line inspector. He was a member of the Destroyer Leader Association, the USS Boston Shipmates and the American Legion.

Richard met his loving wife and best friend, Margaret (Peggy) Jackson, in Bay Shore, New York. Returning to Massachusetts in 1964, Dick worked at the Lakso Co. in Leominster as a machinist, inspector and in production control until his retirement in 1999. Dick loved golf, working around the house, and all the social functions at his Florida home in Japanese Gardens.

Richard was loved by his wife of 55 years, Peggy Moses, along with their daughter, Laura Moses and her partner, Lesley Wassmuth; his son, Bryan Moses (predeceased 1998); his sister, Judith Cadwell and the late Robert Cadwell, and his late brother, Walter Moses and Nancy (Rossi) Moses; as well as many other beloved family members and friends.
