

JOEL TIBBETTS OBITUARY

Joel F. Tibbetts (age 85) entered into rest on February 17, 2022, in Bellingham. He was born on October 1, 1936, in Jamaica Plain, Massachusetts which is a neighborhood in Boston to James E and Mary P (Mahn) Tibbetts. Joel attended Natick High School in Natick, MA, and graduated in 1956.
